PELOPONNESE

The son of two of Greece’s best known consulting oenologists, Yiannis Flerianos graduated with a Masters degree in Oenology from UC Davis and did his practicum at the Robert Mondavi Winery. Yiannis returned to Greece several years ago armed with a commitment to quality and first hand knowledge of American sensibilities about wine. It did not take him long to develop a wine aimed specifically towards the American palate.

In Greece, *hima* is the everyday wine and the wine that flows during festivals and other celebrations. It is in this spirit that the Hima wines were created. Although the Hima wines were conceived with simplicity and value in mind, they are intended for wine lovers of every stripe. The unpretentious *Hima Unoaked Red* is reminiscent of Beaujolais.

Hima Unoaked Red 2003

Variety: St George (Agiorgitiko) 100%

Viticulture: Vines grown in upland valleys at an elevation of 250-350 meters.

Vinification: Classic red fermentation in stainless steel.

Analysis: Alcohol: 12 %
Total acidity: 5.35 gr/l
Res. sugar: 2.12 gr/l
