Lafazanis White

(lah-fah-zah-nees)

Peloponnese

The Lafazanis family were growers in Nemea long before the recent rush of outside investment in the region.

Spyros Lafazanis sources his Rodotis and Moschoudi from north-facing mountain vineyards at 550-600 meters near Aravonitsa in the northwest Peloponnese, just a few kilometers from the Gulf of Corinth.

LAFAZANIS WHITE 2004

varietal: 85 % Roditis, 15% Moschoudi (muscat)

Vinification: Classic white fermentation in stainless steel. No wood contact.

Analysis: Alcohol: 11%
Total acidity: 5.9 gr/l
Res. sugar: 1.4 gr/l
