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LYRARAKIS CUVEE GRAND COLLINE

CRETE

In 1966 the Lyrarakis family became the first quality producer in a region dominated by bulk wine operations. Their 8 hectares of vineyards are located in an upland valley at an elevation of 440-600 meters. This valley creates a corridor of cooling air between the sea of Crete, a few kilometers to the north, and the Libyan sea, about 50 kilometers to the south.

The vineyards are planted with both indigenous and imported varieties. The *Cuvee Grand Colline* blends the traditional Vilana variety with Sauvignon blanc and Sylvaner.

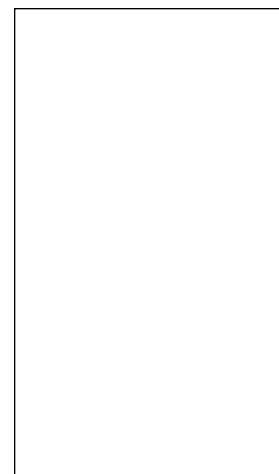
CUVEE GRAND COLLINE 2003

Cepage: Vilana 50%, Sauvignon blanc 30%, Sylvaner 20%

Viticulture: Unirrigated 10-25 year-old vines at 500 meter elevation pruned to 55 hl/ha.

Vinification: Classic white fermentation in stainless steel at 14-16°C for 14 days. No oak contact.

Analysis: Alcohol: 11.7%
Total acidity: 6.15 gr/l
Res. sugar: 1.52 gr/l
