The Lyrarakis family revived this near-extinct variety found growing wild on their estate in Alagni. Dafni is the Greek word for laurel (bay leaf), whose aromas the grape's own resemble. Evidence suggests the variety was used to make wine during Minoan times, approximately 3,600 yrs ago.

Tasting notes:

This wine has aromas of fresh herbs contrasting with delicate fruit and a soft, silky texture. A perfect accompaniment to salads and dishes prepared with fresh herbs like thyme and rosemary.
