The Lyrarakis family was the first quality producer in Crete's Peza region. Their revival of near-extinct grape varieties has opened windows on the past--and future--of winemaking on the island.

Tasting notes:

This blend of two important native varieties with Carignane is reminiscent of a southern Rhone wine. It has spicy aromas, mild cherry flavors, earthy nuances and soft, velvety mouth feel.
